"The word 'Snippets' is apt, for this is not a detailed history of mycology but simply a presentation of a few topics that interest me and I will explain the very limited aims in my Introduction. The standard English-language work is G.C. Ainsworth's 'Introduction to the history of mycology', published in 1976. Since then more information has become available (and shown that some of his observations need modification) and information has become easier to obtain. I give more detail about some topics treated by Ainsworth and include a few that are not in his work. I include numerous colour illustrations, something that would have been very expensive to do in print in 1976. I stress again that these 'Snippets' deal with an idiosyncratic selection of topics. For more, read Ainsworth! It's still well worth it."

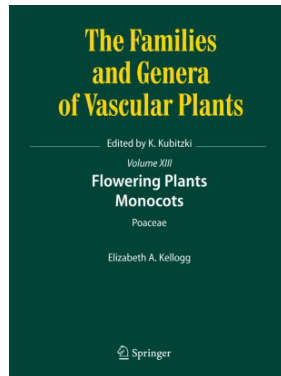
